

Understanding your bill:

The Capital Improvement fee of \$50.00 is to repay the loan, borrowed from the State of Connecticut for pump station repairs and upgrades. This 20 year loan should be "paid-off" during the year 2022.

Residential users: The sewer use fee is calculated by using the information provided by the Regional Water Authority of Greater New Haven. It is based on your first quarter reading (generally your January, February, March bill) multiplied by 4 to equal the yearly total. If that calculation is greater than your actual consumption, the actual consumption is the basis for billing. Plus the \$50.00 Capital Improvement fee added to your total.

Commercial/ business users: The sewer use fee is calculated by using the information provide by the Regional Water Authority. **All water consumption is used** for the basis of billing. Plus the \$50.00 Capital Improvement fee added to your total.

Fees not paid within one month of the due date will become delinquent and subject to interest at the rate of 1.5% per month (18%) per annum from the due date of September 1, as allowed by G.S. 12-45; Interest runs to the last day of each month. **If a bill is not paid by October 1 at 3PM your bill will be consider late.** Contact the Ansonia WPC for additional charges. The minimum interest charge (per CT General Statute is \$2.00)

FAILURE TO RECEIVE A BILL DOES NOT RELIEVE YOU OF THE OBLIGATION TO PAY THE BILL.

If a **previous balance is indicated on your bill**, you have a delinquent sewer use fee due. Please contact Attorney John Androski for further details on delinquent accounts. Past due bill must be paid in full to Attorney Androski before payments on current charges can be accepted.
