# **Motor Vehicle Taxes for Grand List 2016 have been APPROVED**

To all taxpayers liable for payment of property taxes to the City of Ansonia:

We, the City of Ansonia, would first and foremost like to thank you for your patience and understanding during this motor vehicle tax delay.

The motor vehicle tax bills originally would have been mailed to you on July 1, 2017 but because the state budget was not finalized the City decided to postpone the mailing. This decision does not and will not affect the original billing cycle. The motor vehicle tax covers October 1, 2016 to September 30, 2017.

The state budget has been finalized and the City has approved a 37.32 mill rate for the motor vehicles.

The Tax Department would like to inform you that the grand list 2016 motor vehicle bills are **DUE JANUARY 1, 2018 AND WILL NOT BECOME DELINQUENT UNTIL AFTER FEBRUARY 1, 2018**. The Tax Department will be accepting payments in December of 2017 for those who would like to claim the payment for income tax purposes.

Payments may be mailed to PO BOX 253, paid at the tax collector's office during our business hours Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Thursday 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and Friday 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., or paid online at [www.cityofansoniam.com](http://www.cityofansoniam.com).

Failure to receive a bill does not invalidate the tax or interest accrued. The delinquent tax will be subject to interest from January 1, 2018 at the rate of 1.5% per month, \$2.00 minimum in accordance with the provisions of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Section 12-146. You will also be unable to renew your registration with the DMV.
